GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURE

ELIGIBILITY

Applications are invited from exceptional, committed learners who aspire to excel academically and who demonstrate outstanding cultural and leadership potential.

How to apply for a scholarship

- All applications must reach the school before the closing date.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited to write an examination at the school.
- Depending on the outcome of the scholarship examination, applicants may be invited for an interview before the scholarship awards are finalised.



- Successful applicants will be notified as soon as all applications have been finalised.
- The cost of uniforms, stationery and other additional expenses are not included.

The following document must be submitted with your application:

- A copy of the applicant's most recent report.

4. College Senior English and Mathematics Teachers
5. Head of Academics

Conditions for withdrawal of award
